- the provisional title of the paper,
- 250 word synopsis,
- Author's name, telephone and e-mail address.

Receipt of your synopsis will be acknowledged.

Synopses should be submitted by 21st January 2022

Authors will be informed of whether their synopsis has been accepted by the end of January 2022.

Completed papers will be required by 1st May 2022

All accepted papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings
