CRYNODEB

Ar noson yr 2ail o Dachwedd 1925 profodd pentref Dolgarrog, Gogledd Cymru, fethiant trasig argae a arweiniodd at golli 16 o fywydau, 10 oedolyn a 6 o blant, a difrod helaeth i'r gymuned.

Cafodd dau argae eu hadeiladu i gyflenwi dŵr ar gyfer pŵer trydan dŵr i'r ffatri alwminiwm lleol. Ar ôl pythefnos o law trwm, methodd argae Llyn Eigiau, gan ryddhau cyfaint enfawr o ddŵr i argae Coedty ymhellach i lawr y dyffryn. Gwnaeth y dŵr ychwanegol i argae Coedty fethu, ac fe aeth tua 300,000m³ o ddŵr i lawr ochr y mynydd, gan ruthro drwy bentref Dolgarrog.

Arweiniodd y truchineb hwn, ynghyd â'r digwyddiad yn Skelmorlie yn yr Alban, at gyflwyno deddfwriaeth diogelwch cronfeydd dŵr gyntaf y DU yn 1930. Ers hynny, er bod digwyddiadau cronfeydd wedi digwydd, nid oes unrhyw farwolaethau pellach wedi deillio o fethiannau cronfeydd dŵr yn y Deyrnas Unedig.

Bydd ymwelwyr yn derbyn cyflwyniad yn esbonio hanes Dolgarrog a'r digwyddiad ym mis Tachwedd 1925, ymweliad tywysedig i'r or saf bŵer ac i'r cronfeydd dŵr a'r gwaith diweddar a wnaed ar y safleoedd. Bydd yr ymweliad yn gorffen gyda thaith gerdded i'r ardd goffa yn Nolgarrog.

SYNOPSIS

On the evening 2nd November 1925 the village of Dolgarrog, North Wales experienced a tragic dam failure that resulted in the loss of 16 lives, 10 adults and 6 children, and extensive damage to the community.

Two dams had been constructed to supply water for hydroelectric power to the local aluminium factory. After two weeks of heavy rainfall, Llyn Eigiau Dam failed, releasing a vast volume of water into the downstream Coedy Dam. The Coedty Dam was overwhelmed, and approximately 300,000m³ of water surged down the mountainside, flooding the village of Dolgarrog.

This disaster, along with the incident at Skelmorelie in Scotland, led to the introduction of the Reservoirs (Safety Provisions) Act 1930—the UK's first reservoir safety legislation. Since then, while incidents have occurred, no further fatalities have resulted from reservoir failures in the UK.

Visitors will receive a presentation outlining the history of Dolgarrog and the 1925 dam incident, guided visit of the station and to the upstream reservoirs and recent works undertaken at the sites. The visit will conclude with a walk to the memorial garden in Dolgarrog.
