Introduction

As part of the West Cumbria pipeline project Raw water is drawn from THIRLMERE reservoir and treated at this site, after the treatment and prior to distribution the water is to be stored in this the 1st of 3 new service reservoirs on the system. The Tank is to be capable of containing circa 29ML of treated water before flowing onward to the distribution system.
