Call for Presentations

The BDS 15th Supervising Engineers' Forum will take place on Thursday 16th September 2021. Whilst actual arrangements are yet to be confirmed – whether in person at the University of Nottingham, or remote, or both – the Forum will take place.

The current themes of the forum could cover the following topic areas:

- Update on enforcement and compliance
- Updates in legislation and in particular On-Site Plans
- The role of the Supervising Engineer following the Prof. Balmforth review
- Incidents and lessons learnt
- Matters concerning Undertakers
- Industry, research and future direction
- The panel application process, first time and re-appointments

There will be a maximum time limit of 12 minutes per presentation. The presentation sessions are expected to be followed by an open forum discussion. Depending on the final format of the forum, presentations will either be presented live or pre-recorded.

Synopses for presentations are requested relating to one of the above-mentioned themes, or any other topic, that may be directly applicable to Supervising Engineers or Undertakers.

The closing date for submission of synopses will be **Friday 9 July 2021**. Authors of those synopses that are short-listed will be contacted and final presentations requested.

The closing date for submission of final presentations will be **Thursday 2 September 2021**.
