We will be welcoming up to 300 delegates to our conference in Keele this September providing an excellent opportunity for organisations to showcase their services or products.

We are offering exhibitors the following:

- An exhibition space (including a table) in the main conference area in the Chancellor's Building. This will be your space for the duration of the conference.
- All technical sessions, workshops, refreshments and meals (except the BDS Formal Dinner) will be held during the conference in the Chancellor's Building. Delegates will therefore have full access to exhibitors throughout the conference.
- An "Exhibitors' Evening" on the Wednesday (with pop-up bar and inclusive bar vouchers for delegates) provides an opportunity for all delegates to meet with exhibitors and view the presentation space.

The fee for exhibiting is:

- **£1,995** for BDS Corporate members, which includes the exhibitor space and full conference registration for one person in University accommodation (they can upgrade to a hotel for an additional £225 fee if desired).
- **£2,495** for Non-BDS Corporate members, which includes the same package as above.
